

# Wildlife Metaphors

A metaphor is a comparison of two things. Unlike a simile, a metaphor does not use the words “like” or “as.” Use metaphors to compare yourself to animals. On the first line, select an animal. On the next line, explain how you are like that animal. If you need some ideas, you may use the Idea Box.
