English	<p><b>Castle Shape Poem</b> Fill the castle with words! It could be describing words (tall, big, and strong), material words (Bricks, stone) or even words associated with castles (flags, towers). <b>(See resource sheet)</b></p>	<p>Design and make your own shield! Draw all of your favourite things in your shield so that it is unique to you. <b>Challenge:</b> Label your drawings. <b>(See resource sheet)</b></p>	<p><b>Stick Puppets. (See resource)</b> Make a set of puppets for you to use to tell your own dragon story. Put on a puppet show for your family. <b>Challenge</b> - Write a sentence for each character.</p>	<p><b>Reading Tricky Words</b> Colour in the tricky words when you can read them. Practice them each day. How long will it take you to reach the castles? <b>(See sheet).</b></p>
Maths	<p><b>2d Shapes</b> Using the 2d shapes, can you make a dragon picture or a castle picture? <b>(See resource sheet)</b> Top tip: Colour them in before you cut them out! <b>Challenge:</b> Use 2d shapes of your own to create your own picture!</p>	<p><b>Counting</b> <b>Rec</b> - Count the castle objects and write the number into the circle. <b>N</b> - Count the objects using your finger to press each one. Tell an adult your answer. <b>(See resource sheet)</b></p>	<p><b>Repeated Patterns</b> Use the pictures to complete the patterns. <b>(See Sheet)</b> <b>Challenge:</b> Can you make your own dragon themed repeated pattern or even using your toys?</p>	<p><b>Castle Tens Frame</b> Can you use counters or drawings to fill the castle with the right amount? <b>(See Sheet)</b> <b>Challenge:</b> How many will you have if you add two castles together?</p>
Topic	<p><b>Get creative!</b> Using recycled materials, make a model of either;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a dragon,</li> <li>• a castle,</li> </ul> <p>or some dragon wings!</p>	<p><b>Cutting Skills</b> Follow the lines of the dragon carefully, remembering to move the paper and not the scissors too much. <b>(see resource sheet)</b></p>	<p><b>Pencil Control (see sheets)</b> The lines have disappeared from the dragon picture. Draw them back on carefully! <b>Challenge:</b> Use the castle sheet to practice some letter patterns too!</p>	<p><b>Size ordering</b> Can you order the castles by size? You could order them smallest to biggest, or biggest to smallest! <b>(See resource sheet)</b></p>

Can you think of any TV programmes or films that have dragons in them? What sort of characters are the dragons? <b>Challenge:</b> Draw a poster of you favourite dragon characters talking together. What will they say?</p>	<p><b>Dragon School!</b> Zog is a young dragon who wants to be the best at his dragon school however he has a lot of accidents! Can you make a dragon school in your home or garden? Think about all the things you will need to teach Zog if you were his dragon teacher. You could teach him some phonics so that he can read the signs around school, or even help him to learn how to fly!
