Control measures going to and from school	<b>Pupils and Staff</b>	Risk of Infection	<p><b>Children</b> will arrive and leave school through a staggered timetable, using a one-way system and entering their classroom via their own classroom door.</p> <p><b>Children</b> to walk, cycle or be driven to school where possible, to avoid public transport.</p> <p>Children will be dropped off and collected from the Red Gate (Y1-Y6), Green Gate (Rec).</p> <p><b>Children</b> in Nursery will be walked around to the Nursery entrance by parents/carers prior to other children being on the school path.</p>			✓

			<p>least 60% alcohol) for those who have been given parental consent.</p> <p>Children will be allocated a seat in their classroom, which will try not to face them directly towards another child or staff member.</p> <p>Doors and windows open where possible, to allow for ventilation</p> <p>Children to work in outside areas where possible.</p> <p>Intimate care and first aid to be carried out using PPE (aprons, gloves)</p>			
Children or staff members displaying symptoms	Pupils and Staff		<p>If a child or staff member is displaying any symptoms of COVID 19 they must not come to school.</p> <p>If a child or staff member is displaying any symptoms of COVID 19 whilst they are at school, they will be placed in isolation away from their classroom bubble.</p> <p>Parents/carers will be contacted and asked to collect child.</p> <p>Head teacher will then inform other agencies as and when required.</p> <p>Child or staff member to be tested.</p> <p>If test is positive, the class bubble will close for 14days,</p> <p>If the test is negative, the child or staff member can return to school to re-join the class bubble.</p>	Medium		✓
Sharing resources	Pupils and Staff	Risk of infection	<p>Children will be allocated personal set of resources (pencil, pen, ruler, wipeboard, wipeboard pen, scissors, glue)</p> <p>Each class will have a pack of wipes and/or or spray bottles of disinfectant and disposable cloths for cleaning of any surfaces or resources.</p> <p>Classroom surfaces will be cleaned throughout the day by the caretaker and also at the end of each day by the cleaning team.</p>	Low		✓
Breaks	Pupils and Staff	Risk of Infection	<p>Children will take breaks outside with their class bubble only, on a staggered timetable.</p> <p>Children will be required to wash hands regularly throughout the school day, including before and after meal times, and after using the toilets.</p>	Low		✓

			<p><b>Children</b> to eat food in their classroom area where possible or if weather is nice consider eating outside. School lunches provided and collected by class TA each day. <b>Staff</b> will take breaks in the hall, where social distancing of 1m+ can still be adhered to. <b>Children</b> will not use outdoor fixed-play equipment (tyres, trim-trail, climbing frame)</p>			
Welfare Facilities	<b>Pupils and Staff</b>	Risk of Infection	<p>Hand washing must be adhered to before starting school and after visiting the toilets and prior to eating and drinking. Hands to be washed for at least 20 seconds in hot soapy water. Hand Sanitiser is available and should be used as and when required by staff and those children who have been granted parental consent. Avoid touching face as much as possible. Cleaning is on-going throughout the school day</p>	Low		✓
Spread of Infection to vulnerable relatives in household	Relative s	Infection Control	<p>Continue to follow the most recent Government information from Department for Education (DfE), guidance from Health Protection Team (HPT) &amp; Public Health England (PHE). Limit activities to low risk Wash hands on a regular basis, particularly at end of shift with warm soapy water or with an alcoholic hand sanitiser (at least 60%) On entering household, prior to potential contact with vulnerable household members:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Remove shoes</li> <li>- Remove all clothing and wash items in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. Use the warmest water setting and dry items completely.</li> <li>- Shower immediately, including washing hair, put on fresh clothing</li> </ul>	Medium		✓
